Materials You'll Need

Cast On

1. Using your size 6 needles, cast on 180 stitches.

Lace Pattern

2. **Row 1:** Knit 1, *yo, k2tog, yo*, repeat from * to * to end of row.
3. **Row 2:** Knit all stitches.
4. **Row 3:** *Ssk, k1*, repeat from * to * to end of row.
5. **Row 4:** Knit all stitches.
6. **Rows 5-24:** Repeat Rows 1-4.

Body

7. Continue knitting in the lace pattern until the piece measures approximately 23 inches from the cast-on edge.
8. **Armhole Shaping:** Bind off 20 stitches at the beginning of the next two rows.
9. Continue knitting for 4 inches.

10. **Shoulder Shaping:** Bind off 25 stitches at the beginning of the next two rows.
11. Bind off the remaining stitches.

Sleeves

13. Using your size 6 needles, cast on 75 stitches.
14. Knit in the lace pattern for 12 inches.
15. **Armhole Shaping:** Bind off 15 stitches at the beginning of the next two rows.
16. Continue knitting for 4 inches.
17. **Cuff Shaping:** Bind off 5 stitches at the beginning of the next two rows.
18. Bind off the remaining stitches.

Assembly

19. **Sewing Shoulders:** Using the tapestry needle and yarn, sew the shoulder seams together.
20. **Attaching Sleeves:** Sew the sleeves to the armholes, matching the lace pattern.
21. **Weaving in Ends:** Use the yarn needle to weave in any loose ends.

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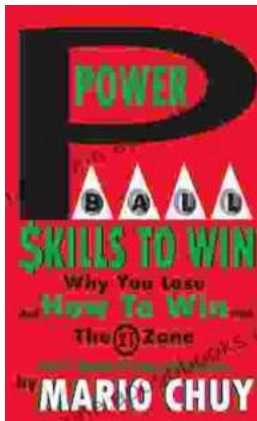
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
